Dear Constituent,

After years of dithering and failing to deliver results on the Trans Mountain Expansion pipeline, the Ottawa Liberals are still no closer to getting the project built. One bad decision after another by this Liberal government has meant that the project has been stalled indefinitely. **Canada's Conservatives are calling on the Liberal government to take immediate action and fix the mess that they created by taking the following four steps:**

- 1: Support Bill S-245 to clarify that the pipeline is under federal jurisdiction and in the national interest of Canada.
- 2: Get a stay of the Federal Court of Appeal ruling and appeal the ruling to the Supreme Court of Canada.
- 3: Appoint a Ministerial Special Representative to complete the indigenous consultation process.
- 4: Affirm that the original analysis of the tanker traffic was sufficient and does not need to be repeated by the National Energy Board.

The Ottawa Liberals have an obligation to Canadians to take immediate action and remove all barriers to the pipeline's construction.

Andrew Scheer, the leader of Canada’s Conservatives, has **announced the steps a Conservative government would take to reverse the Ottawa Liberals’ failed energy approval policies** and ensure that Canada is a place where energy investments are encouraged—not scared away. These steps include:

- **Repeal Bill C-69, the Anti-Pipeline Bill**

 - ⇒ **End foreign-funded interference in regulatory hearings**
 - ⇒ **Provide certainty on approval timelines and schedules**

Conservatives have called on the Ottawa Liberals numerous times to outline their plan to get the Trans Mountain pipeline built, get Canadians back to work, and restore investor confidence in Canada. As of yet, the Ottawa Liberals have provided no plan to get the pipeline built and no plan to protect energy jobs in Canada. Unlike the Ottawa Liberals, Canada’s Conservatives would have not piled up new regulations and red tape, would have not introduced a bill that effectively bans the future construction of pipelines, and would have not introduced an oil tanker ban or implemented a job-killing carbon tax. **The Ottawa Liberals must act now to clear all obstacles to the construction of this pipeline.**
